SUBJECT: Policy Recommendations

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At the April 15 Board of Education Meeting, two policy revisions will be placed on the agenda. The Policy Committee meeting minutes, the information contained in this memorandum and the specific policy changes will provide the background information for the Board of Education. The agenda items are as follows:

**Policy 2430 – Co-Curricular Uniform Code of Conduct**

Academic eligibility issues that were brought to the Board's attention were addressed. The proposed revisions to this Policy will provide students the ability to regain eligibility for co-curricular activities if they enroll in either a fee-based credit recovery program or fee-based tutoring program and demonstrate significant progress. The above mentioned credit recovery and tutoring programs must be District provided programs. This will resolve the inequities inherent in the existing policy. A copy of the new language in the Policy will be provided to the Board of Education in the agenda packet.

A request to waive the First Reading will be made and adoption of the revisions to this policy are recommended at the April 15 Board Meeting.

**Policy 2435 – Technology Resources Acceptable Use Policy**

This Policy has undergone a complete review and rewrite. A sub-committee, chaired by Mr. Linell, was charged with review of this Policy and Procedure. The sub-committee was comprised of teaching, administrative and technology staff. The Policy and Procedure have been completely rewritten to align with current technology usage and to ensure that they are easily understandable for users. Additionally, legal counsel has reviewed the revised Policy and Procedure and have provided input. A First Reading will be held at the April 15 Board of Education Meeting with no action being taken. A copy of the rewritten Policy and Procedure will be distributed to the Board of Education prior to the meeting.
