5. Total compensation form	ROEA presented that the delivery of the total compensation information is unnecessary, in light of Michigan politics at this time, and requests the practice be discontinued. Administration pointed out that this is not an assault on staff, but a typical, annual communication of information. There is no attempt to present anything but factual information.
6. Development of student schedules in absence of Dept Chair at ROHS	Discussion to express concern over reduction of ROHS Dept Chairs continued.
7. Extra compensation for a ROHS teacher	The issue remains unresolved.
8. MYP and World Language classes	The Curriculum Office and a ROMS World Language teacher will be invited to the next JC meeting to continue the discussion about 10 sections of World Language in 2011-12.
9. Credits to advance on salary schedule	Administration confirmed the basis for determining credits to apply toward salary advancement. Graduate level classes and/or classes which are part of a graduate degree requirement are accepted. Credits toward an additional endorsement, provided the university determines them to be graduate credit classes, are also accepted. The university makes graduate level determination.
10. Teacher Student Data Link (TSDL)	The TSDL is now active in the state of Michigan. More information will be provided to all teaching staff about the impact of TSDL, which may be in the areas of course offerings, coding of courses, gradebook, attendance, HQ, certification and assignments. Please look for new information and ask questions if needed.
11. PD credit for attending 6 th grade camp	Cheryl will consult with the Instruction Office to determine if camp may be considered PD for this purpose.
